


Travelling to Turku

Flights

Please be aware that flights to Turku may be infrequent. We recommend travelling with Finnair to Helsinki, followed by a Finnair bus to Turku. The bus stop at Helsinki Airport is conveniently located near the arrivals hall, with clear signage to the bus stops.

When booking your flight with Finnair, ensure that Turku is listed as your final destination (Turku XTZ = Turku Bus Station). This will automatically include the 2-hour bus ride as the second leg of your journey. Travelling with Finnair is often also the more cost-effective option compared to other airlines.

The Finnair bus operates twice daily in both directions:



If the bus service is not included in your airline booking, you can purchase a bus ticket through <u>Finnair</u> or directly on the bus.

If the Finnair bus schedule does not align with your arrival time in Helsinki, you can also book a seat via Matkahuolto bus company.

Be sure to check your hotel's location - here are some convenient stops:

- Turku River Aura: Tuomiokirkkotori, 20500 Turku
- Turku Railway Station: Junakatu 9, 20100 Turku
- Turku Tuomiokirkko / Turku Cathedral: Tuomiokirkonkatu 1, 20500 Turku

Train

It is also worthwhile to check the train schedule from Helsinki Airport to Turku as an alternative. Helsinki Airport's train station is located under the terminal. There is a direct elevator and escalator connection from the departures and arrivals hall to the train station.

Tickets can be bought at the vending machines at the train station at the airport. The train journey will take about 2 hours 20 minutes, **with one change at Pasila station**.
